As announced in November 2017, the Bishops of England and Wales will rededicate our land as the Dowry of Mary on the Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord 2019. This title is a most ancient one, meaning that England is 'set apart' and given to Our Lady. King Richard II in 1381 dedicated England to Our Lady at a special ceremony in Westminster Abbey. The rededication in 2020 will not be the gift of a country but the personal gift of the faith of the people of England to the Mother of God to seek her help in building a strong spiritual foundation for the New Evangelisation. We call upon Our Lady to guide and protect our nation in the years to come, as we work to build a culture that respects life, embraces diversity and serves others, especially the poor and the marginalized.

The Holy House at Walsingham was built as a perpetual reminder of Mary's joy at the Annunciation and birth of the Redeemer. During this year of preparation we have been asked in particular to pray the Angelus.
